

Key Terms of the Bible Course: Student Handbook

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Practice in identifying the key terms in your language in order to use them when you teach

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The head of a Bible Institute in Colombia went to visit one of her prize students, a member of a minority language group. She was in the kitchen before the service, and everyone was conversing with enthusiasm in the local language. She couldn't understand a thing except when someone addressed her with a stilted "Buenos Dias." Then she went to the preaching service. As her prize student preached, she was surprised how much she understood. As a matter of fact, she thought that minority language was a lot like Spanish. Words like justification, repentance, judge, and others sounded almost like Spanish. Then she looked around and saw that most of the people seemed to staring off into space. They had their minds elsewhere. Some of the older ones were even nodding their heads and drifting off to sleep.

The prize student was using the skills he had learned at the Bible institute, and the key terms were being spoken in the language of wider communication.

For 15 years after Marlene told us her story I thought, *there has to be a way you can teach in a Bible School with Students from different languages with each one using his own language to do their assignments.* In 2004 I had the opportunity to try out my dream. I taught a course in a Colombian Bible Institute to help students discover how Key Biblical Terms had been translated in their languages. The course is for Scripture Use not Translation. The assumption is that they have at least some Scripture available in their language.

Purpose:

This book is designed with the purpose of using Scriptures already available in the Mother Tongue. The Basic assumption is that the user of this manual has the New Testament or at least some books of the New Testament available in his Mother Tongue. Because of the predominance of training in National languages, there is a need to deliberately (intentionally) focus on important theological terms in the Mother Tongue. It is a simple manual with scripture references to passages where the key words are used in different contexts. If the book is used in a multilingual context the depth of meaning and scope of the term comes out in the discussion of how the term has been translated in different languages.

Problem:

When a person studies a subject in a language that is not their mother tongue, they cannot quickly translate new concepts in this subject matter into their own language. The new terms of this study are not easy to translate. *"There are many words in the Bible that are of particular theological importance for translators, perhaps because they deal with specifically Jewish or Christian ideas and customs, or because they are used in special ways in the Bible. Often they introduce an idea that may be previously unknown, or little understood, in the area for which the translation is being made"*¹. A Bible translator takes, hours, days and sometimes months or years to find just the right word or phrase to express certain Biblical concepts. First he studies the passage using the word in context. He uses commentaries, dictionaries, the original languages to get the best understanding of the term. Then he thinks of possible ways of translating it. He tests these for understanding with more speakers of the language and consults. It only seems logical that pastors and teachers should take advantage of the study that has been done rather than trying to translate instantly as they preach. When pastors and teachers try that, they most commonly borrow all the important words from the language of wider communication and loose their audience. Before preaching on a key biblical term, the leader must know how was translated in his language.

For this reason Bible Institutes, Seminaries, and churches, should encourage those who study the Bible to use the translation in their own language and investigate how important terms were translated. They will become familiar with the terms and feel comfortable using them when they preach.

If the student becomes accustomed to using the Scriptures in his own language in Bible school, Seminary or church, he will learn to read the Scriptures in their own language fluently. Having confidence in his ability to read fluently in public will be of great value in leading his people in worship and Bible Study. One of the most common factors contributes to lack of use of the Scriptures in their own language is not having confidence in their ability to read them in public for lack of practice.

Many of the terms in the Bible have more than one meaning. It is very important to be aware of these different senses and realize that the term was translated in accordance with the meaning in each context. This means that the same word in the original language may be translated in different ways in the receptor language according to the context.

Additional Benefits:

A side benefit of the Key Terms course is that the students see that the professors in the Bible Institute value their language and the Translations in their language.

Objectives upon completion of the course a speaker with the Scriptures in their own language will be able to:

- identify how key terms in their language are translated.
- use the terms when they teach or preach.
- better understand the doctrine based or related to the key term.
- attach greater value to the Scriptures in their language since they know that there are appropriate ways to communicate key terms in their own language and that it may be to change according to the context.
- use the Scriptures with more confidence and to motivate other people of his ethnic group to do so.

Presentation:

There are 43 lessons, i.e. lessons for 5 days a week for 9 weeks, with an assignment of an hour each day. As an alternative you can give them a day to do homework in groups of the same language in the class and the other day for discussion in class. (I've done this in a workshop of a week with selected terms. We alternated hours between an hour of work in groups of speakers of the same language to do the assignment, and the next hour in the large group of all languages.)

Format:

Each lesson has the same format and instructions for the assignment as follows:

1. Look up each Scripture reference in the Scripture in your own language. Read it aloud.
2. Write the answers first in your language and then in English.

Assignment:

If there is more than one student from a language group let them work together to do the assignment. However, each student should have a manual and write the answers in his own manual. Each day the student will be assigned Scripture references to look up in his own language. There will be several verses for each word to see how it is translated in different contexts with different senses. Some lessons are longer than others and it may take several days of class to finish them.

The Class:

The class consists of a discussion of the assignment. It is not a lecture by the teacher but a dialog between the teacher and the students. It is important to establish an atmosphere where the students feel free to speak without fear of being laughed at.

1. Ask the students what the term is in their language and the literal translation (back translation) of the term in English.
2. Ask one from each language give his literal translation of the term in English. Each one may be different because of the way the language functions. The teacher should write all the back translations on the board. Group those with similar meanings. This helps give greater understanding of the term.
3. Ask the question in the last column to add to the discussion if there is time.

Preparation of the professor:

The *Translators Workplace* CD has a book *Key Biblical Terms Help for Bible Translators*, by Katherine Barnwell. It gives suggestion on ways to translate the important words in different contexts. The teacher should read the appropriate section in preparation for each class.

If you find other terms that are not in the manual you can use the same method to help the student understand them.

Materials needed

1. The New Testament en the language of the student. If the New Testament is not complete the student should have manuscripts of the portions that are available.
2. The Student workbook *Key terms of the Bible Course*.
